Meeting Called to order at 7:05 pm

Welcome and Minutes from prior meeting approved

Athletic Director Report-The winter sports have started and are going very well. The girls basketball is 19-0 and 7-0 in league. Girls' Water Polo is 6-0. Boys soccer is tied for 1st. Playoffs will start in 3 weeks. Our Athletic Director, Jason Rosenthal, was awarded Coach of the Decade by the Daily News.

Team Representative Reports- Spirit team is hosting the Regionals competition this Saturday at our gym from 10-2 and there will be 25 teams attending. The girls basketball will be playing Thousand Oaks, their rivals, so please come and support them.

Spring Event Fundraiser-4th Annual ASB and Charger Club Dinner Dance and Silent Auction will be held at Fiamme Restaurant (formerly Alessio's) in Westlake Village, Sunday March 28, 2010 from 5-10pm. To volunteer, contact Diane Addison, Spring Event Chairperson. Team baskets are due March 5th and can be dropped off in L-4 or call Diane Addison. Team baskets should be in the amount of \$100-\$300. They are still in need of auction items. There are forms on back table for donations. The invitations will be by e-mail and RSVP's will need to be by March 5th. Tickets will be \$45 per person, which includes 2 raffle tickets. Spirit team will be at competition in Orange country that weekend, so Julie will let them know if there is room and could come that night if the competition ends early enough. A team rep expressed disappointment that is going to be held on Palm Sunday. The board and members of the general membership discussed how hard the Charger Club is working to avoid calendar conflicts and be supportive of the athletic teams at the school.

Football Snack Stand - Snack bar raised \$11, 308 even though attendance was down. They made a diligent effort to keep expenses to a minimum.
