

Charger Club General Meeting Minutes
Feb. 16, 2010 Meeting - @7:05 pm

Welcome and Minutes from prior meeting approved—Diane Addison made the motion and Cathy Chavez seconded the motion.

Team Representative Reports-The Spirit team went to Nationals in Florida. They made it to the semi-final round. Missed finals, because they changed the criteria even though they did their routine flawlessly, it wasn't difficult enough. All levels of girls' water polo made it league finals and Varsity made it to CIF. Eight wrestlers made it to CIF. Girls' soccer is in a rebuilding year and was 4-8-2. Boy's basketball made to CIF. Girls' basketball are league champs with a record of 26-0 and are going to CIF and ranked 10th in the state. Boy's soccer is going to CIF. Lacrosse starts March 8th at Westlake.

Treasurer's Report- All required financial reporting has been completed. A statement of income and year to date expenses was handed out to the members.

Coaches Survey Results—Discussed the 10 surveys that were returned. Most coaches want Charger Club's support and are interested in working together with Charger Club.

Conejo Valley Days- It will be April 28th to May 2nd. Community members will be charged a flat fee of \$495 for a booth and food booths are being limited. David Silverman requested a check for the booth fee. Motion passed to provide the \$495 fee. Proceeds from the booth are returned to Charger Club after the close of the event.

They are still in need of auction items. There are forms on back table for donations. 1800 invitations were sent out. Alpha Printing donated a portion of the cost of printing the invitations. On March 10th the committee will be putting together baskets.

Merchandise Sales—Still need volunteers to sell at the games. Still available: sweatshirts, stadium chairs, fleece blankets, and photo frames. The sweatshirt prices will be going up next year due to increases in supply and delivery costs.

Cruise Tickets—Over all we have sold 760 tickets. Sales will end at the end of February. Contact Sharon McDonald for details. Your team will get \$5 for each \$10 ticket sold.

New Business—Charger Club entered a contract with Coke. We are receiving 4 coolers--2 front door (1 will go to the gym and 1 in the snack shack) 2 sliders that will go in the back of the snack shack. Robin Felton (boys soccer) offered to donate a used refrigerator to hold other items if we need it. Jeanice will contact her to see if it is something Charger Club could use.

Assistant Principal—He asked if the Charger Club would be willing to donate \$3800 for the installation of the Scoreboard, which 6 sports would utilize. Opened to discussion. A lengthy discussion went on. Several suggestions were made on how the funds could be raised, such as selling advertising that could run on the scoreboard, or the senior class gift to the school. Another suggestion included finding a person that would be willing to donate a large amount and have the scoreboard named after them.
